

- 2 Pull the air filter housing outward slightly and disconnect the 2 hoses at the back of the housing See Figure 70 and Figure 71
- 3 Remove the screws from the backside of the housing and remove the chrome plate and hose (Figure 72)
- 4 Remove the air filter (Figure 73)
- 5 Tap the element lightly to remove most of the dirt and dust, then apply compressed air to the inside surface of the element
- 6 Inspect the element and make sure it is in good condition Make sure the air filter sealing surface **(Figure 74)** is not torn Replace if necessary
- 7 Clean the inside of the air box with a shop rag and cleaning solvent Remove any foreign matter that may have passed through a broken cleaner element
- 8 Assemble the air filter housing assembly When installing the air filter housing make sure that the 2 hoses (Figure 71) are connected to the filter housing (Figure 70)

## Crankcase Breather Hose

Inspect the hose for cracks and deterioration and make sure that the hose clamps are tight (**Figure 75**)
